ADMISSION GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

B. A. & B.Com (Hons) Degree: Higher Secondary or other equivalent examination (CUET qualified) and 40% marks in the subject of choice for honours at the Higher Secondary

Higher Secondary: Secondary (Matriculation) from any recognized Board for Arts and Commerce streams, and a minimum of 40% and 45% marks in aggregate respectively

ADMISSION PROCESS

- * Admissions begin soon after the declaration of MBOSE Secondary and Higher Secondary results.
- * Admission forms and prospectus can be purchased from the College office on payment of ₹ 300.
- * Walk-in admissions to students who secured a first division in Secondary and Higher Secondary
- * Candidates, accompanied by parents, should meet the Principal/Vice-Principal for an interview.
